**RACE DESCRIPTION:** A mixture of well built single-track and wide open ski trail, the course at Nordic Mountain promises to provide a fun introduction to high school mountain bike racing. With its many passing opportunities, flowing singletrack, and just the right amount of technical challenge to keep all interest, this rolling course starts with a moderate climb and rolls through the wooded and grassy terrain through the cross country ski trails. This will be a great spectator course. **Course distance is approximately 4-5 miles.**

I-39/US 51 S to Exit 136, Hwy 73 east to C-R P. East on P to Hwy 22 to C-R G. Left on G through Mt. Morris to C-R W. Left on W less than 1 mile to Nordic Mountain on left.

**FROM THE SOUTH**

I-39/Hwy 51 N to Exit 124, Hwy 21 east to Wautoma. Left on Hwy 152 to C-R W. East on P to Hwy 22 to C-R G. Left on G through Mt. Morris to C-R W. Left on W less than 1 mile to Nordic Mountain on left.

**REGISTRATION INFO**

We recommend avoiding long lines and taking advantage of early on-site registration hours Saturday, Oct. 3rd from 2:00 PM – 5:00 PM, otherwise during the regular registration hours on Sunday, Oct. 4th from 8:00 – 9:30 AM. Riders must register at least one hour before race starts! If you have not signed your release forms electronically, please bring signed participation waivers to registration tent.

**On-site registration:**

On-site registration will result in a late fee of \$10 for WI League Registration and \$10 for Race Registration. All racers must register at least one hour prior to their start time. *To make race day more enjoyable, register in advance online!*
